It should be used as a guide by teachers and administrators in selecting materials that enhance SE learning and practice in the classroom. In the Notes section, the person filling out the form should enter specific recommendations for items to be purchased.

The “Overall rating” for each area is a rating between 1 and 5, where 1 is “this area does not exist or there are no items to support SE development in this area,” and 5 is “this area offers a large quantity and variety of items to support SE development, and there are no SE materials needs for this area.”
